

Efficient Order Management





Real-time fund calculations

EDI X.12 Compliant Option

Enables libraries to deliver orders directly to vendors using the EDI X.12 standard. VERSO Acquisitions supports 850 (ordering), 855 (acknowledgment), and 810 (invoice) transactions through a single system to all EDI X.12 compliant vendors including – Baker & Taylor, Ingram, etc.

Robust Selection Lists Feature

Gives libraries the option to create and use an unlimited number of selection lists with the option to populate them manually, from Z39.50 searches, or from MARC uploads. Libraries have the ability to individually add new titles on the fly which load directly to the order. Consortium capability to check for duplicate purchases across all consortium members.

Detailed Fund Management Capabilities

Delivers libraries real-time access to the library funds. Funds can be assigned as many as five library-configured fund categories to satisfy local reporting needs. Fund management also provides alert thresholds per fund and the ability to better manage funds for the next year with multiple financial year rollover options.

Robust Vendor Management Options

Offers real-time access to vendor performance statistics. Provides libraries with the ability to create vendor aliases and subaccounts with linkages to local account numbers.

MARC Upload of book carts from your vendor

Enables upload of unit-level book cart data from your book vendor, including Fiscal year, Fund, Material Type, Price, Quantity, Destination, and local notes. Uploaded data automatically populates the selection list for increased efficiency.

Branch Profile Distribution Functionality

Provides branch level management; enables libraries to store unlimited numbers of profiles for book purchasing of predetermined quantities. These feed directly to the order at the time of order. Branch Profiling offers the flexibility to edit, override or augment orders at the time of purchase.
